Statement of Faith

1. We believe that the sixty-six books of Holy Scriptures as originally given are in their entirety the Word of God inspired by the Holy Spirit and wholly without error in all that they declare; therefore are the supreme and final authority in faith and life.
2. We believe in the one Triune God — Father, Son and Holy Spirit.
3. We believe in the Virgin Birth and the Deity of Jesus Christ, the eternal Son of God, who is also Son of Man with two distinct natures and one Person forever.
4. We believe that the substitutionary death of Jesus Christ on the cross made atonement for the sin of the world and is efficient for those who believe.
5. We believe in the bodily resurrection of our Lord Jesus Christ which insures resurrection of all believers who have received God's gift of eternal life.
6. We believe in a punitive judgment in regard to unbelievers who reject the gospel.
7. We believe in an evaluative judgment for believers.
8. We believe it is by the gift of grace we have been saved, not by works of man.
9. We believe that man was originally created in the image of God, fell into sin through the first Adam, and he is responsible for all sin he has committed. Sin causes him to be separated from God and lost eternally.
10. We believe that salvation from everlasting punishment and entrance into a state of fellowship with God are secured only by a personal belief in Jesus Christ; who bore our sins in His own body on the cross; and by a definite receiving of Christ, receive the Holy Spirit into one's inner being.
11. We believe the Holy Spirit indwells all those who receive Jesus Christ as both Savior and Lord.
12. We believe that the Holy Spirit is responsible for the quickening from death into life and for the continuing sanctifying work in a believer.
13. We believe that the church is the body of Christ, assembled of born again believers, called to be identified with Christ in baptism and participate in the Lord's Supper in remembrance of His death.
14. We believe all believers are called to be in the world but separate from it.
15. We believe that Christians are loved by God, and freed from their sins by His blood and has made them to be a kingdom and priests to serve God the Father, through Jesus, by the power of the Holy Spirit.
